

SMALL GROUP LEADER'S GUIDE – SEPTEMBER 12 & 15 – NORTH CAMPUS

LESSON: CREATION

- MATERIALS FOR CRAFTS, THE LEADER'S GUIDE AND LESSON BOOKLETS (ONE FOR EACH CHILD), AS WELL AS ACTIVITY PAGES WILL BE ON YOUR CLASSROOM TABLES TO ALLEVIATE TIME CONSTRAINTS BECAUSE OF THE CHURCH SERVICE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING;
- EVERYBODY MEET IN THEIR SMALL GROUP CLASSROOMS TO START THE SESSION;
- FIRST BELL – EVERYBODY MEET FOR LARGE GROUP. **LEADERS PLEASE REMAIN WITH YOUR GROUP DURING THE LARGE GROUP TIME (THE BLUE CHAIRS ARE AVAILABLE FOR YOU TO USE);**
- TODAY'S SCRIPTURE – GENESIS, CHAPTERS 1 & 2;
- GROUP CRAFT: **CREATION WHEELS – NO PREPARATION NEEDED** - THIS PROJECT IS FOR EVERY AGE GROUP TO DO DURING SMALL GROUP TIME;
- ALSO DURING SMALL GROUP: SHARE HIGHS AND LOWS, REVIEW THE LESSON and SHARE HOW THE LESSON MIGHT RELATE TO EVERYBODY'S LIVES, ETC... GROUP LEADER'S BRING SNACK IF YOU WOULD LIKE. **DUE TO FOOD ALLERGIES - SNACKS WITHOUT TRACES OF NUTS PLEASE!** SNACKS AT NORTH CAMPUS ARE ALSO AVAILABLE FOLLOWING WORSHIP UPSTAIRS– **BEFORE CHURCH SCHOOL.**

SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS:

1. In how many days did God create the world? Six
2. What were all the things that God created? The heavens and the earth, wind, water, light(day), darkness(night), the atmosphere(sky), plants to separate the water from the dry land, the sun and the moon (so we would have seasons), life in the seas and birds in the air. Then God created animals on the land and finally God formed human beings.
3. What did God breathe into human beings that was something none of the animals had? A living, eternal spirit in the image of God himself.
4. How did God feel about what he had created? (Listen to all answers and maybe write down some of the "feeling" words that the children come up with). Genesis 1: 31 – God saw everything that he had made, and indeed, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.
5. What did God do on the seventh day? He rested! God called the seventh day holy. (Genesis 2: 3 – So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all the work that he had done in creation. God wants us to take time to rest too.) Sunday is called the Sabbath and is meant to be set aside for worship and rest.
